
LANDSCAPE REGISTRATION

- Qualified Water Efficient Landscaper (QWEL) certification
 - Replacing GreenCO Best Management Practices as registration requirement
 - QWEL is a more in depth training program
 - Costs of QWEL are comparable but time requirement is higher
- Landscape and irrigation companies now required to register
 - Each registered company to designate a Responsible Landscape Professional (RLP) as primary point of contact
 - RLPs must be QWEL certified and pass Castle Rock Water's test
- Registered companies and individuals will be held accountable when landscape and irrigation criteria are not followed




LANDSCAPE REGULATIONS

- Removed Class II compost as an approved amendment
- Irrigated landscape no longer allowed within street medians, islands, or round-a-bouts
- Added Section 9
 - Inadvertently excluded from the previous revision
 - Covers parks, sports fields and golf courses



NOTIFICATION AND OUTREACH

- Presented to stakeholders
 - Developer's Roundtable
 - Economic Development Council
 - Design firms
 - Builders
 - Landscape Contractors
- Sent emails and letters to all landscape companies and registered individuals
- Held virtual stakeholder meeting for landscape contractors
- Several companies and individuals contacted Castle Rock Water with requests for clarification
 - Those requests were addressed on an individual basis
