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2024 is the 150th anniversary of Castle Rock's founding. While the town recognizes 1881 as the anniversary of Castle Rock's incorporation, in 1874 the town was made county seat of Douglas County, a two story courthouse was built, the Castle Rock post office was moved, and New Memphis moved to Castle Rock.

We propose to purchase 45 Viewmaster sets and 45 custom reels from a firm in Oregon. By ordering that amount we move to a price point of \$20 per set. 15 sets each will be provided to the Chamber of Commerce, the Philip and Jerry Miller Library's Archive group, and the Castle Rock Museum. We intend to load the custom reels with photos taken as soon as possible after 1874 of historic Castle Rock buildings and scenes. Photos' source will be an existing town historic tour brochure, the library archives, and perhaps others. The recipients of the sets will be asked to offer them free of charge to individual and group tours.

We will provide an individual to the Council's June meeting to discuss CCGP grants.
