### **SUMMARY**

#### **2023 STANDARDS OF COVER**

The 2023 Standards of Cover is an in depth analysis of our historical performance in terms of call volume, call types and level of risk for the jurisdiction as a whole, five station areas, and ten planning zones.

This document, together with the 2021 Community Risk Assessment, identify the risks within the community, define the level of service the Fire and Rescue Department can provide, establish historical performance baselines, set realistic performance goals (benchmarks), and identify performance gaps.









### STANDARD OF COVER

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- 1. Defines risk by service type (fire, EMS, tech rescue, HAZMAT, wildland) for all planning zones
- 2. Levels of Service: Critical Task Analysis ensure compliance to SOGs, firefighter safety, and efficient use of resources
- 3. Establishes performance guidelines
- 4. Performance Gaps:
  - PZ6: Cobblestone Ranch, Liberty Village
  - PZ7: South/East portions of district: Stone Cañon Ranch, Lake Gulch Road area
  - PZ8: Dawson Trails, Keene Ranch, Twin Oaks



### STANDARDS OF COVER

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Continue to monitor its performance in Planning Zone 2 to determine if the increase in compliance is a single year event or if the overall trend is improving.
- 2. Continue the physical and financial planning for Station 156 with a goal of opening the station in mid-late 2026.
- Closely monitor medic unit call volume, utilization, and call distribution as they are approaching the planning thresholds established in the 2021 Fire Master Plan.

- 4. Closely monitor Planning Zone 9 (PZ9) for growth, increasing calls for service and performance.
- 5. Monitor the potential growth in Planning Zone 8 (PZ8) to anticipate changes that may drive the need for additional resources.
