### HISTORY OFFICERS IN SCHOOLS



The School Resource Officer (SRO) program is a cooperative agreement between Douglas County School District (DCSD) and Town of Castle Rock (TOCR) endowing a 50 percent cost sharing for school officers

| July 2006  | Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) – one (1) SRO for Castle View High School (CVHS). Two (2) SROs for Castle Rock Middle School (CRMS) and Mesa Middle School (MMS) were added by 2018.  |

| July 2013  | Following the 2012 Sandy Hook Elementary shooting, CRPD and DCSD signed an IGA for School Marshal Officers (SMO) covering the Town's elementary and alternative schools.  |
| June 2023  | Town Council approved Aspen View Academy (AVA) request to fully fund an SRO for AVA   |
| March 2024 | Town Council approved World Compass Academy (WCA) request to fully fund one (1) SRO for WCA   |
| Current    | All School Marshal Officers became School Resource Officers. Currently CRPD has six (6) officers<br>and (1) SRO Sergeant: four (4) full-time (CVHS, CRMS, MMS, AVA) and two (2) covering 15<br>elementary and alternative schools. In the 2024-2025 school year, one (1) additional SRO for<br>WCA. |

### ROLE OF SRO IS MULTI-FACETED

- Safe and secure learning environments
- Valuable resources to school staff members
- Foster positive relationships with students
- Develop strategies to resolve problems affecting youth
- Protect all students so they can reach their full potential



- School safety and security plans
- Practicing drills (e.g., fire, secure, lock down, shelter in place)
- Investigates/follows up on school threats
- Member of School Crisis Team
- Member of Threat Assessment Team

# ROLE OF SRO

- Educator (i.e., guest lecturer)
- Informal Counselor
  - Work alongside students each school day
  - Build rapport and trusting relationships
  - Identify behavioral concerns early
  - Provides timely intervention
- Law Enforcement Officer



## **BUDGET IMPACTS**

#### Net Zero

- Seeking approval for an amended IGA funding two (2)new SROs.
- Douglas County School District (DCSD) will fully fund two (2) SROs, to include start up cost for one year. The SROs would start in August of 2024 for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Each SRO will be funded by DCSD at \$145,887.77 per FTE, for a total of \$291,775.54 for salary/benefits. Each FTE will also receive an additional \$125,000 for startup cost, for a total of \$250,000 in startup costs.
- DCSD total contributions for two (2) SROs, including startup cost for one year will be \$541,775.54
- The amended IGA would begin in July of 2024 and would cover the 2024-2025 school year. After year one, these positions will be eliminated without an additional funding source.
