In addition to providing high-quality educational opportunities, these events will boost local economic activity and strengthen community connections. By hosting programs in partnership with local businesses, we will help increase foot traffic and encourage residents and visitors alike to explore Castle Rock's vibrant local economy. Families attending our live wildlife experiences will have opportunities to shop, dine, and engage with participating businesses—creating a positive ripple effect that supports local commerce while fostering community pride.

1876 Castle Rock (influential building replicas)

The Castle Rock Historical Society and Museum (CRHSM) has an exciting plan for the 250-150 Celebration. We envision creating a collection of “mock-up” façades (replicas) of historic Castle Rock buildings from near 1876. The replicas of influential buildings will initially include the 1875 Cantril (First) Courthouse, the 1873 City Hotel (moved to CR in 1877) and a “Star Saloon”. A replica of the 1875 railroad depot has been created by the Douglas County Fair Board. We’re planning to borrow the depot replica for the display. The Fair Board has five other generic replicas which they may loan to us for the display. The proposed replicas as part of this grant are strategically planned to be a foundational effort to build a replica of Castle Rock in the late 1800’s and to which additional historic building replicas can be added. This project builds on the 1981 celebration of the 100th anniversary of Castle Rock in which a whole block of replica buildings were made and displayed on Wilcox Street; however, they were not constructed to last more than a weekend. The replicas will be lumber and plywood mock-ups with front faces constructed, trimmed, and painted to resemble the historic structures, and scaled to emulate the dimensions of the originals with heights of approximately 8 to 12 feet, depending on the building. A skilled team will design, fabricate, and paint the replicas. The “mock-up” façades will be created to be broken down and easily stored. They will be weatherproofed so they withstand the elements for many years of use and be transportable and available for display at various venues. The CRHSM has orchestrated projects of this type in the past and is thrilled to be considered to do this again, especially for the 250-150 Celebration. The replicas are planned to be ready in May 2026. The CRHSM will partner with the Town Parks and Recreation Department to determine the best location to assemble and display the replicas for the Town’s 2026 250-150 festivities.
