CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

THE 2021 PARKS AND RECREATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN IDENTIFIED THE NEED FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT:

- Butterfield Crossing Park
- Mitchell Gulch Park
- Plum Creek area parks
 (Plum Creek North Park / Plum Creek South Park)

Improvements will address maintenance needs, life cycle replacement, accessibility and improve user experience.




LOCATION MAP

DESIGN AND PUBLIC PROCESS

FEBRUARY 2020

Contracted professional landscape architecture firms, DHM Design and Design Concepts, to engage community to create improvement plans.

FALL 2020

Design firms used resident feedback to create renovation master plans for each site.

SPRING 2020

Design firms met with Town staff to review current and future recreation programming needs, maintenance issues and potential enhancements for each site.

FALL 2020

Design firms posted the renovation master plans and invited the public to provide comments.

SUMMER 2020

Design firms posted surveys and invited residents to provide feedback.

WINTER 2020

Design firms incorporated feedback and comments into final renovation master plans.

BUDGET

THE CONSERVATION TRUST FUND HAS \$4.5 MILLION AVAILABLE FOR PROJECT DESIGN, PERMITTING AND CONSTRUCTION COSTS. PRIORITIZATION WILL ADDRESS CAPITAL REPLACEMENT NEEDS AND ACCESSIBILITY FIRST, FOLLOWED BY ENHANCEMENTS.

- Portion of Conservation Trust Fund comes from Douglas County Shareback
- .17% sales tax distributed to municipalities in Douglas County
- County Commissioners approved funding distribution in January










MITCHELL GULCH PARK CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO

NEXT STEPS

March 2021

Finalize contracts to obtain construction drawings, specifications and bid documents for each site

April 2021

Design and review process begins; will likely take 4-6 months

Fall 2021

Acquire permits, seek competitive bids for construction and obtain Town Council approval of projects
