The surge began mid-march after the first Stay at Home order was issued, a report says.

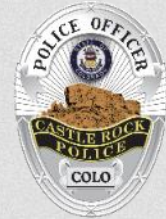

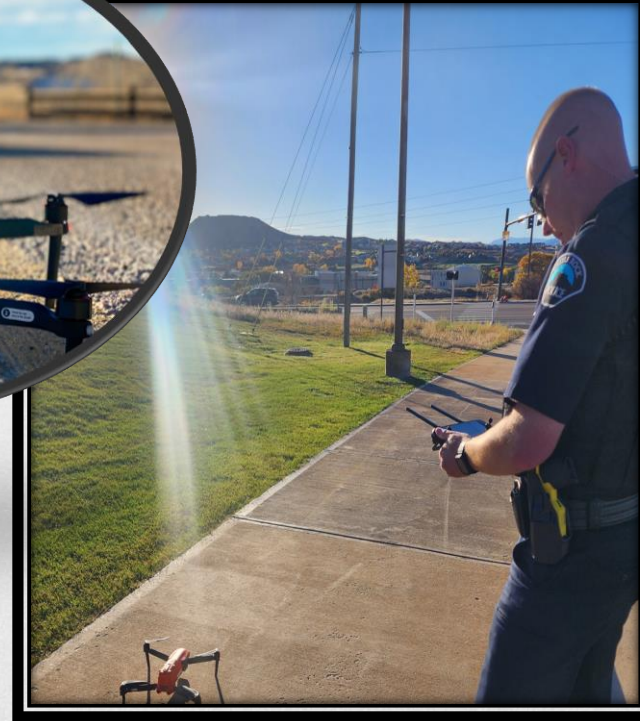

CURRENT CRPD DRONE PROGRAM



- Flying in the Town since 2021
- Currently have 10 drones in service
- 9 Pilots- from Patrol and Special Ops
- Estimated 750+ flights in 2024





WHY DRONES FOR FIRST RESPONDERS?

- In Strategic Plan
- Instantly deployed/launch capabilities
- 400ft
- Battery swap/limited down time
- Improved Coverage/availability
- Video feed can be shared with command
- Thermal/Night Vision
- Resource multiplier
- Compliments existing drone program
- Provides real-time info to officer for safer more efficient response

POLICY

PROHIBITIVE USES

The UAS video surveillance equipment shall not be used:

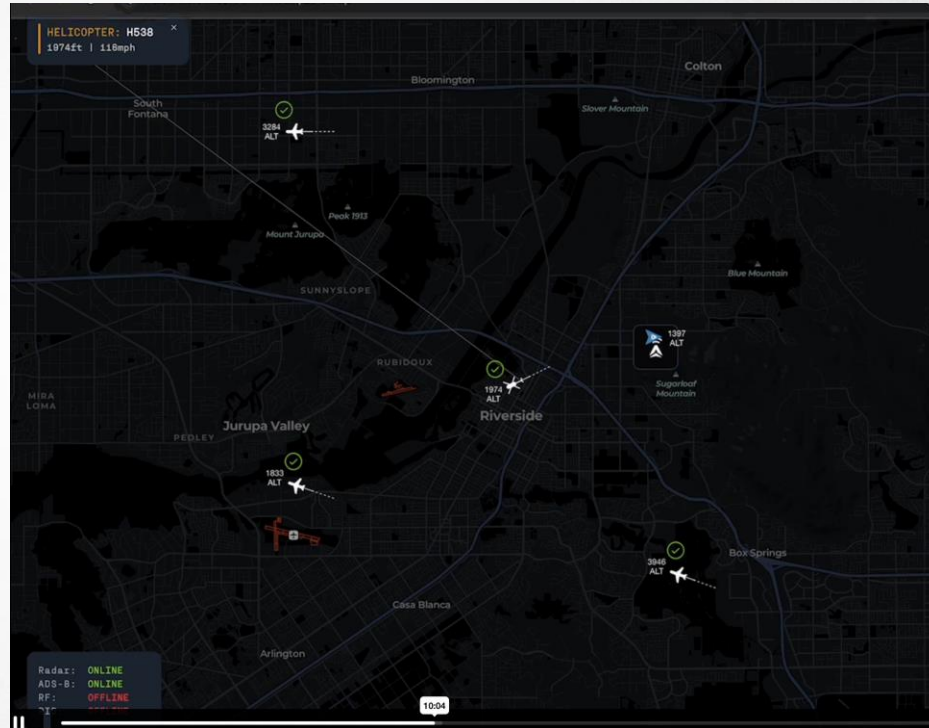
- To conduct random surveillance activities unless otherwise identified in an established operations plan
- To target a person based solely on individual characteristics, such as, but not limited to race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, disability, gender or sexual orientation

- To harass, intimidate or discriminate against any individual or group
- To conduct personal business of any type

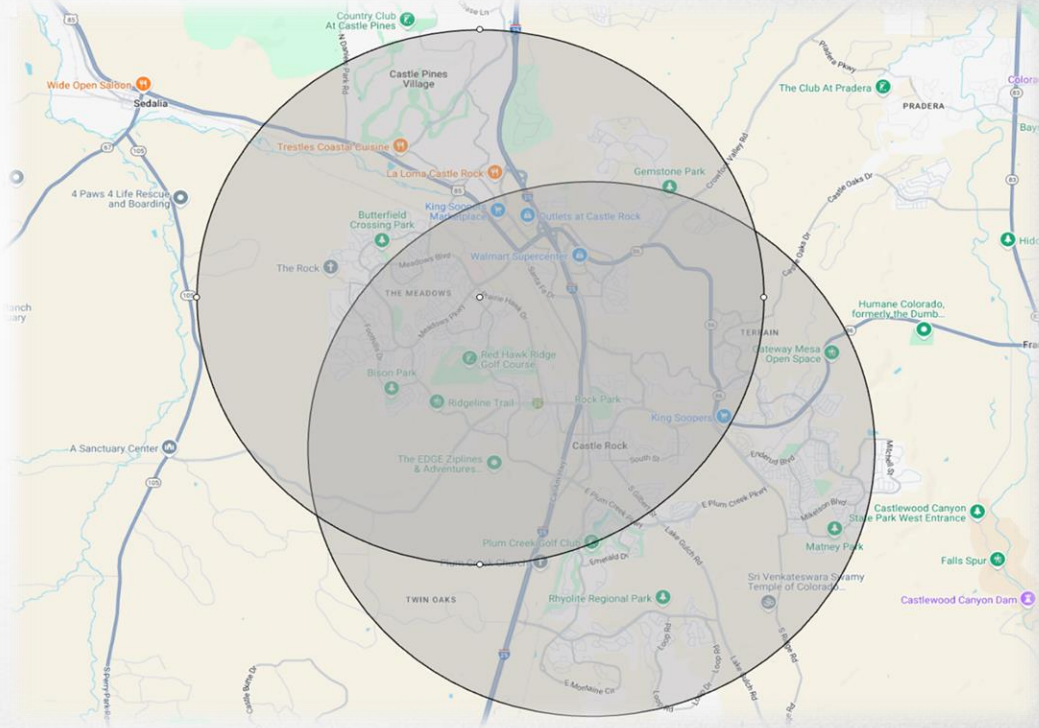

AGREEMENT

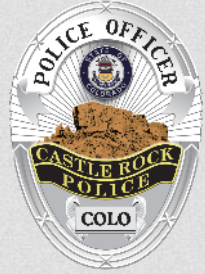
DETAILS

- 3-year lease for two drones
- 200k per year – substantial discount for early adoption
- All maintenance and repairs included
- Flock coordinates obtaining the FAA waiver
- Staff provided by Flock until FAA waiver is obtained
