OVERALL, THE FINANCIAL CONDITION OF THE TOWN CONTINUES TO BE STRONG. AS OF THE END OF THE THIRD QUARTER, TOTAL TOWN REVENUES ACROSS ALL FUNDS ARE 4.3% OVER THE YEAR-TO DATE BUDGET AND ARE ESTIMATED TO END THE YEAR 2.4% OVER THE 2016 BUDGET.

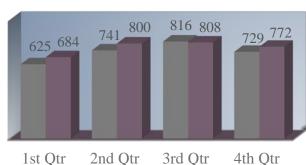

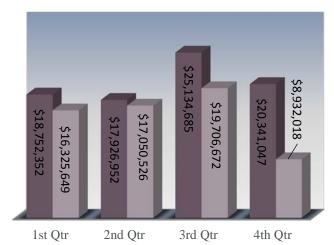


ACCOUNTS PAYABLE / PURCHASING

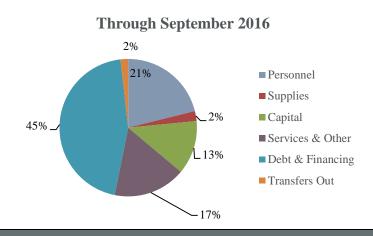

BUDGET DEVELOPMENTS

- 5th amendment to the 2016 Budget presentation to Council on October 4th to accommodate a refund of the 2015 TABOR surplus, contingent upon results of the election in November. Second reading and adoption occurred on October 18th
- 6th amendment to the 2016 Budget to accommodate additional building inspection costs in the Development Services enterprise fund was approved on first reading and adopted on second reading by Council on October 18th
- Prepared a 7th Amendment to the 2016 Budget to accommodate additional costs for the redevelopment of Festival Park. Presentation and approval on first reading by Council occurred on October 18th with second reading on emergency adoption planned for November 1st
- Prepared an 8th amendment to the 2016 Budget to accommodate the purchase of water rights and infrastructure in Douglas County. First reading to Council is planned for November 1st, with second reading on emergency adoption planned for November 15th

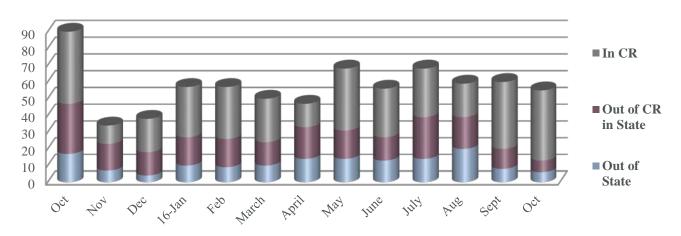

This graph illustrates how many business licenses are issued per month, by area.

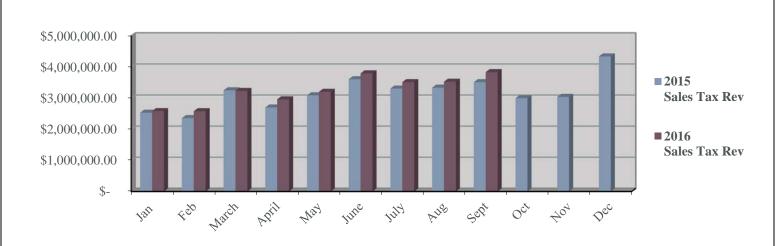
