RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2017 STORMWATER MASTER PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, the Town Council previously adopted the Stormwater Master Plan (SWMP) in 2004, which was subsequently updated in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Town is committed to protecting water quality while providing the community with exceptional service that protects public health and balances social, environmental and fiscal responsibilities in a sustainable manner; and

WHEREAS, the SWMP provides for a long-term program to ensure drainage and other systems control stormwater runoff, protect the public during major storms, protect property values, safeguard Town streams from pollutants carried by urban runoff, and balance storm drainage planning approaches to complement open space and recreation corridors; and

WHEREAS, the SWMP outlines stormwater and floodplain problem areas and recommends timeframes and priorities for specific drainageway improvement projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the Castle Rock Water Commission recommended approval of the 2017 Stormwater Master Plan update.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. **Approval.** The 2017 Stormwater Master Plan update in the form attached as *Exhibit 1* is hereby approved.
