A proposal to construct a new medical office building to include a freestanding emergency department. The proposed project is located west of the intersection of Plum Creek Boulevard and Crystal Valley Parkway.



Pine Canyon Annexation and Zoning, 6 p.m., Hybrid @ Town Hall Council Chambers, 2nd Meeting A proposal to annex and rezone the 535 acres known as Pine Canyon. The proposal includes a maximum of 1,800 mixed residential units, commercial uses to include a hotel/resort and other business and industrial uses. The proposed project is located on both the east and west sides of I-25, west of Founders Parkway.



Scileppi's Phase 2, 6 p.m., Virtual, 1st Meeting

A proposal to demolish the existing addition on the west site of the Old Stone Church, located at 210 Third St., and build a new addition within the same footprint. The property is located southeast of the intersection of Jerry St. and Third St.

A proposal for a mixed-use paired home community on the 4-acre property located on the southeast corner of Crystal Valley Parkway and West Loop Road. The site plan proposes 30 units and 3,000 square feet of neighborhood commercial space.

 - Evaluate policies
 - Engage the public, including Downtown businesses and elected officials, in the process
- Staff expects to hire a vendor this spring/summer to kick off the study, which will be paid from the Downtown Special Fund
