Honoring the 50th anniversary of the Castle Rock Senior Activity Center

Whereas the Castle Rock Senior Activity Center invites those in the community age 50+ to join in “loving life in the second half;” and

Whereas the center is marking its own 50th anniversary this year, having gotten started in 1971 in the Blue Flame Room of Wilcox Street’s Peoples Natural Gas building, which is now home to Castle Rock Music; and

Whereas the center enjoyed other notable homes prior to moving in 1997 to its present location within the Castle Rock Recreation Center: Castle Rock’s oldest building, the old “City Hotel” on Perry Street; the old train depot on Elbert Street that’s now the Castle Rock Museum; and the church on Third Street that’s now Castle Rock Baptist; and

Whereas the chronicles of the center’s members are just as storied as the buildings the group has occupied – hundreds of its members have together embarked on adventures to theaters, casinos, restaurants, to go white-water rafting and beyond; and

Whereas the nonprofit center also fills vital roles by providing transportation services, nutritious meals, wellness activities and more within the community. This work has been especially important over the past 16 months, as the center has supported local seniors through the COVID-19 pandemic; and

Whereas, because the center has reached this significant milestone, more than 1,100 local residents are able to enjoy friendships, opportunities to stay active, and chances to share their time and talents – like crafting – with the community, touching lives throughout the Castle Rock area.
