## Per Municipal Code 3.02.060:

Purchases over five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) and up to seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00) require three (3) informal written bids unless approved by the Town Manager on the basis of sole source, emergency or unresponsive bidders.

Purchases over seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00) require formal written sealed bids unless waived by the Town Manager for purchases up to and including two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) or by Town Council for purchases over two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000.00) on the basis of sole source, emergency or unresponsive bidders.

Replacement of all existing LifePak cardiac monitors that are reaching their end-of-life cycle of ten years. Replacing all of our equipment at once would allow for a more efficient deployment and streamlined training among our personnel and would help minimize equipment issues because the Department would not need to maintain multiple systems.

This replacement has been budgeted in the General Long-Term Planning (GLTP) fund, and funds are currently available to complete this purchase at a cost of \$723,696.16. The resolution is scheduled to go before Council for approval on August 20, 2024.
