

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-074

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH
INLINER SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR THE YOUNG AMERICAN
INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS SANITARY SEWER
REHABILITATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado (the “Town”) has determined that Inliner Solutions, LLC (the “Contractor”), as a contractor that specializes in Cured-In-Place Pipe (“CIPP”) projects, is best suited to provide sanitary sewer rehabilitation services using CIPP for the Young American Infrastructure Improvements Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, subject to Town Council’s approval, the Town and the Contractor have agreed to the terms and conditions by which the Contractor will provide sanitary sewer rehabilitation services using CIPP for the Project (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, Town Staff recommends Town Council approve the Agreement with the Contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The Agreement between the Town and the Contractor is hereby approved in substantially the same form as presented at tonight’s meeting, with such technical changes, additions, modifications, deletions, or amendments as the Town Manager may approve upon consultation with the Town Attorney. The Mayor and other proper Town officials are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and any technical amendments thereto by and on behalf of the Town.

Section 2. Encumbrance and Authorization for Payment. In order to meet the Town's financial obligations under the Agreement, the Town Council authorizes the expenditure and payment from the CIP/Young American Rehab account in an amount not to exceed \$322,837.00, plus a Town-managed construction contingency in the amount of \$32,284.00, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Town. The total authorized payment under the Agreement, including the construction contingency, is \$355,121.00.
