The program consists of hands-on learning applications and leadership methods viable for shaping self-efficacy and increasing capacity for science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. The program utilizes the learn-it, lead-it, and perform-it educational model to assist adolescent girls with self-confidence, problem-solving, and decision-making while influencing overall STEM persistence.

How does this project benefit Castle Rock residents?

Lady Trailblazer, Inc. Girls' Persist program benefits the Town's youth by advancing evidence-based efforts by providing an equitable STEM leadership program specific for girls 12-17 years of age. The Girls' Persist program has contributed to the Town of Castle Rock by its intentionality and deliberate efforts to help girls develop self-confidence and shape problem-solving skills in the effort to persist in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields. Lady Trailblazer, Inc., Girls' Persist program impact throughout 2021 consisted of:

- Hosted two successful Girls' Persist sessions and recognized twenty student/participants with recognition certificates, paraphernalia, gift cards to purchase school items from Target and Walmart, and provided free meals.
- Mentored three student/participants and recognized each with peer leader training certificates (train the trainer).
- Hosted an annual team-building event at Bolwero for all student/participants at no cost to local families.
- On boarded, Officer Amanda Lane (Castle Rock Police Department) as the Director of Community Engagement.
- Recognized three community leaders for their leadership excellence and philanthropy.
- Selected and recognized a local student, Jordan Smith, as the 2021-2022 Lady Trailblazer Ambassador.

Lady Trailblazer, Inc. Girls' Persist 2022 upcoming activity:

- Girls' Persist session dates: January 12, 2022-May 4, 2022-twenty-one students currently registered.
- Girls' Persist recognition ceremony-May 11, 2022
- Host an annual team-building event with the Castle Rock Police Department Explorers' program between June and July 2022.

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
