ORD 2024-008

Ordinance Amending the Castle Rock Municipal Code by the Adoption of a New Section 1.10.020 to Permit the Carrying of Firearms in the Castle Rock Town Hall and Providing for the **Emergency Adoption of this Ordinance on First and Final Reading**

Mike Hyman, Town Attorney, presented the item. They are bringing back our ordinance in response to SB 24-131 that passed this year prohibiting carrying of firearms in sensitive places. The bill does allow governing bodies to opt out. It goes into effect on July 1. They recommend emergency reading requiring 6 votes prior to the July 1 date. He reached out to the County attorney to see if they want the Town to exempt the County building that is within the Town but has not heard back.

Councilmember Brooks wanted to confirm the language is included. Hyman stated it is within the Ordinance.

Councilmember Hollingshead confirmed this would maintain the status quo within the Town.
