

Grants

Public Works was awarded a \$190,000 grant from the Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG). This grant will be used for central software upgrades and signal system communication upgrades. The goal is to improve signal system reliability. Currently process requirement changes are being worked on with DRCOG and CDOT so that purchase orders can be put in place so this project can get underway.

- \$47,142 in Audit Revenue for September 2015




DID YOU KNOW???

request and work together to determine

sales tax.
