

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-050

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK REGARDING COST SHARING TO ESTABLISH THE LINK ON DEMAND MICROTRANSIT PILOT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County (the “County”) has commissioned an Integrated Transit and Multimodal Study (the “Study”) regarding enhancements to the transit and multimodal transportation network throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, acting on recommendations made by the Study, the County is undertaking activities for microtransit services; and

WHEREAS, thus far, the County has established the Link on Demand microtransit service in the Highlands Ranch Metropolitan District in 2025 and in Stonegate and Parker in 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Rock (the “Town”) was identified in the Study as a jurisdiction which would benefit from expanded microtransit services; and

WHEREAS, the County has asked the Town to partner with it on the expansion of microtransit services as recommended by the Study; and

WHEREAS, the initial microtransit service zone for the Town will be coterminous with existing Town boundaries and will include enclaves of unincorporated Douglas County that lie within those boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the one-year cost for the enhancement and expansion of microtransit services associated with the Link on Demand pilot program to the Town (the “Pilot”) is estimated to cost \$2,000,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the County is requesting that the Town contribute \$400,000.00 to defray a portion of these costs; and

WHEREAS, Town Staff recommends that the Town Council approve the terms and conditions of an intergovernmental agreement between the County and the Town establishing the Pilot (the “IGA”); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The IGA between the County and the Town regarding cost sharing to establish the Link on Demand microtransit pilot program is hereby approved in substantially the same form as presented at tonight’s meeting, with such technical changes, additions, modifications, deletions, or amendments as the Town Manager may approve upon

consultation with the Town Attorney. The Mayor and other proper Town officials are hereby authorized to execute the Contract and any technical amendments thereto by and on behalf of the Town.

Section 2. Encumbrance and Authorization for Payment. In order to meet the Town's financial obligations under the IGA, the Town Council authorizes the expenditure and payment in an amount not to exceed \$400,000.00, unless otherwise authorized in writing by the Town.
