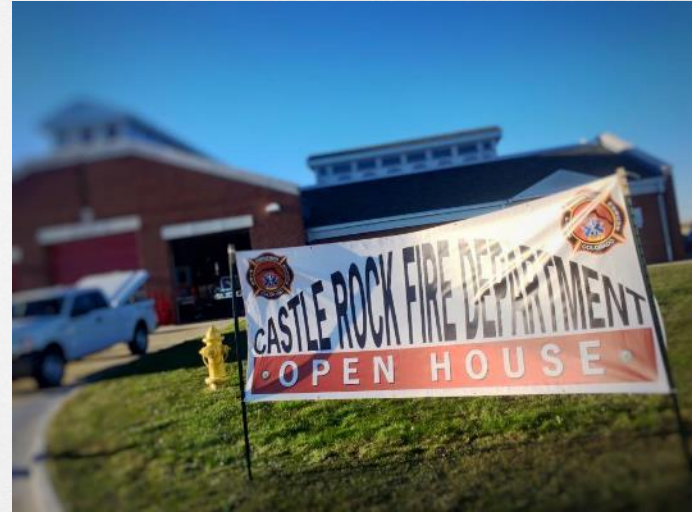


# 2016–2019 STRATEGIC PLAN

## THE PROCESS

- Castle Rock Fire and Rescue hosted seven community open houses at various fire stations or community centers to provide a brief overview of the Department's deployment, capabilities, staffing and funding.
- We collected feedback on the community's
  - Priorities
  - Expectations
  - Concerns
- The Strategic Plan and subsequent goals were developed by a 18 members internal stakeholder group representing all shifts and ranks within the Department
- The Strategic Plan was presented to the Public Safety Commission on May 5<sup>th</sup>, and received an unanimous recommendation for adoption.
