

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT COMMUNITY RISK ASSESSMENT AND STANDARDS OF COVER, 2021 EDITION

WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Rock (the “Town”) has adopted the 2020-2024 Strategic Plan to provide direction for the growth and development of the Fire and Rescue Department and the emergency and prevention services provided to the Town and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Fire and Rescue Department, through the Fire Chief, has prepared an updated Community Risk Assessment and Standards of Cover (the “2021 Standards of Cover”), in accordance with the model established by the Commission on Fire Accreditation International; and

WHEREAS, the Fire and Rescue Department recommends that the Town Council approve the 2021 Standards of Cover; and

WHEREAS, Town Council finds that the 2021 Standards of Cover constitutes a data driven, historical review of the Department’s performance, identifies risks within the Town, and provides significant value in establishing performance benchmarks for the next five years, subject to annual review and update.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approval. The Town of Castle Rock Fire and Rescue Department Community Risk Assessment and Standards of Cover, 2021 Edition, is hereby approved in substantially the same forms attached as *Exhibit 1* and *Exhibit 2*, with such technical changes, additions, modifications, or deletions as the Town Manager may approve upon consultation with the Town Attorney and Fire Chief.
