

EMERGENCY ADOPTION OF ORDINANCES BY TOWN COUNCIL

DECEMBER 7, 2021



EMERGENCY ORDINANCES – CRMC § 2.02.100.E

- Ordinances adopted on an emergency basis are done so for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety
- Language in the ordinance must provide a reason for emergency adoption
- If adopted by Council as an emergency ordinance, the ordinance will take effect immediately, instead of 30 days after publication

ORDINANCES PROPOSED FOR EMERGENCY ADOPTION

ITEM 10 - ORD 2021-030 Third Amendment to 2021 Budget

- To ensure revenues and expenditures are accounted for in the 2021 fiscal year

ITEM 11 - ORD 2021-24 Adoption of 2022 Budget

- To ensure December 15th deadline is met to certify the Town's mill levy to the County

ITEM 12 - ORD 2021-027 Changes to Water, Wastewater, and Stormwater Fees and Rates

- To ensure these changes take effect on January 1st

ITEM 13 - ORD 2021-026 Mill Levy

- To ensure December 15th deadline is met to certify the Town's mill levy to the County

ITEM 19 - ORD 2021-031 Downtown Development Authority Mill Levy

- To ensure December 15th deadline is met to certify the DDA's mill levy to the County
