


PROJECT BACKGROUND

- Phase 1 Rehabilitated 7 interceptor manholes in 2020
- Staff inspected and evaluated 25 downstream manholes in 2021
- Severe to moderate corrosion from sewer gases
- Request for proposals issued in October 2021







PROJECT APPROACH

- 5 proposals received \$455,623 to \$979,920
 - 3 did not propose acceptable structural rehabilitation methods listed in RFP
- C&L Water Solutions proposal selected (\$960,095) based on best overall value
 - Products traffic load rated corrosion resistant composite inserts and epoxy coatings
 - Experience w/ over 150 insert installations
 - Successfully completed Phase 1 at 30% under contracted amount
 - Garver Engineering pre and postconstruction inspections



BUDGET, SCHEDULE, RECOMMENDATIONS

- Budget: \$1,056,095 (total authorization)
 - \$960,095 (contract amount) + \$96,000 (10% contingency)

• 2022 Schedule

- Jan Mar existing manhole inspections, remove failed liners, project public outreach
- Mar May material procurement, bypass planning, preconstruction preparation work
- Jun Oct rehabilitation construction
- Oct Nov site restoration and closeout
