

**Public Art Advisory Committee Meeting with the Jurisdictions**  
**Dec. 14, 2021 at 2 p.m.**  
**Meeting Summary**

**Introductions**

Allissa Dailey from the City of Lone Tree attended the meeting and was introduced to participants.

**Rules and Regulations**

- **Stipend**

Artists selected to participate in the program receive an \$800 stipend from the jurisdiction their sculpture is selected to be featured. The stipend will remain at this amount for the 2022-2023 program year, but will be increased to \$1,000 for the 2023-2024 program year.

- **Entries**

The Rules and Regulations currently state that artists may submit up to three existing, completed sculptures. This will be updated to allow up to 5 entries per artist.

- **Friendly Reminder – Sale Price**

The sale price of the sculpture should remain the same price as the artist listed in their application.

- **Art Encounters Website**

The County is revamping its website, which may result in changes to the Art Encounters website. More information will be provided when it is available.

- **Judge's Choice Award**

The judge selected for the Judge's Choice Award receives \$200 and is reimbursed for mileage. This will remain the same for the 2022-2023 program year, but increase to \$250 for the 2023-2024 program year.

- **Stickers and QR Codes**

The library prints and posts stickers near their sculpture stating that it may be hot to the touch. The library will create and print QR codes for all sculptures to connect people to the voting website to vote for their favorite piece.

**Application**

No changes were recommended to the application that was used this year.
