BACKGROUND

- Wheeling Agreement with PWSD
- Alleviates a 'bottleneck' to WISE flows
- PWSD has no need for new capacity until 2027
- Council approved IGA with PWSD on March 16, 2021.
- Castle Rock to fund, and PWSD to pay back early 2024
- Burns & McDonald (Engineer's) Constr. Cost Est. = \$10,895,250
- Bids received from five prequalified Contractors.
- Bids range from \$10.3M to \$12.8M.
- Garney is low bid of \$10,312,868



KEY FEATURES

- Two main construction tasks:
 - \circ Pipeline
 - Canyon's Pump Station
- Garney has a proven record on Town projects

BUDGET & SCHEDULE

- Garney Construction Bid: \$10,312,868
- Contract Price \$10,312,868 + 3% contingency \$309,386 = \$10,622,254
- Total expected project cost = \$11,137,868 (Design, Construction Phase Eng, Construction)

<u>Budget</u>

- \$14,415,520 for 2022.
- Costs first paid from approved 2022 Bond Funds

<u>Schedule</u>

• Completion of project is expected by Fall of 2023
