BACKGROUND

- Wheeling Agreement with PWSD
- Alleviates a 'bottleneck' to WISE flows
- PWSD has no need for new capacity until 2027
- Council approved IGA with PWSD on March 16, 2021.
- Castle Rock to fund, and PWSD to pay back early 2024
- Burns & McDonald (Engineer's) Constr. Cost Est. = \$10,895,250
- Bids received from five prequalified Contractors.
- Bids range from \$10.3M to \$12.8M.
- Garney is low bid of \$10,312,868

- Two main project components:
 - **Pipeline**
 - **Canyons Pump Station**
- **B&McD** Construction Phase Services

BUDGET & SCHEDULE

- B&McD Construction Phase Eng. Cost: \$328,859
- Total project costs including design, construction phase engineering, and construction: \$11,137,760

Budget

- \$14,415,520 for 2022.
- Costs first paid from approved 2022 Bond Funds

Schedule

Completion of project is expected by Fall of 2023
