#### [PAC 2022 -053](#) **Approval of the Minutes of October 13, 2022**

#### [PAC 2022 -054](#) **Staff Updates**

Staff provided the following updates:

##### **Gary Godfrey Photographs**

In late 2021, Councilmember Cavey suggested honoring local businessman and Castle Rock proponent Gary Godfrey with a memorial bench and the purchase of one or two of his photographs to feature in Town Hall as he had passed away in December of that year. Per this direction, town staff purchased two photographs, which are now installed at Town Hall. The framed photography will now be part of the Town's permanent public art collection. Public art funds, however, were not used for the purchase or framing.

##### **Public Art Conservation**

Pacific Coast Conservation commenced work to restore and clean public art pieces throughout town. Their work will continue throughout 2022-2023 to complete a large majority of the collection. Staff will provide a summary of the pieces restored at the conclusion of

their efforts likely in January or February so planning discussions can take place early next year to prioritize remaining pieces requiring conservation.

**Winter Schedule**

With the year coming to close, staff confirmed the general schedule with members. It was also determine to host a social event in December instead of a regular meeting and directed staff to coordinate details.

Members continued discussions pertaining to the Town's next public art plan, including the prioritization of community engagement objectives and an overview of potential funding options to expand available resource for public art. An update was also provided by staff on the purchase of the Cantril School. Staff invited members to attend an open house to provide public feedback on November 30 at the school at 5 p.m.
