# AMENDING MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING LARGE VEHICLE PARKING AND DEFINITION OF ABANDONED VEHICLE

## RIGHT OF WAY PARKING

### **BACKGROUND**

April 18, 2023: Castle Rock residents requested Town review of Municipal Code regarding large vehicle and trailer parking in the public right of way

#### CONCERN

Residents concerned about safety in residential areas and vehicles/trailers remaining in place for extended periods of time

### **COLORADO HB 22-1139**

HOAs not permitted to prohibit use of public rights of way beyond local government provisions

#### **STAFF REVIEW**

As directed by Town Council, staff reviewed provisions regarding large vehicle parking (Chapter 10.16) and the definition of abandoned vehicles (Chapter 10.20) in Municipal Code

The following proposed amendments would allow Castle Rock Police enforcement, and if desired, HOAs could also choose to enforce parking in the public right-of-way to the extent of the Town Code provisions

### PROPOSED CODE AMENDMENT

### **VEHICLE LOADING/UNLOADING**

Staff also recommends amending Chapter 10.16.020 of Town Code to clarify that vehicles can remain in the public right of way for short periods of time when actively <u>rendering services</u>, in addition to loading/unloading

Services are further defined as <u>deliveries</u>, <u>service calls</u>, <u>accepting articles for removal or delivery</u> and <u>related</u> commercial activities
