RESOLUTION APPROVING A VARIANCE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 9.16.070E OF THE CASTLE ROCK MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE MEADOWS 5 LIFT STATION PUMP REPLACEMENT

WHEREAS, the Town's Utilities Department has made application for a variance to the Town's noise ordinance pursuant to Chapter 9.16.070E of the Castle Rock Municipal Code, necessary for the Meadows 5 Lift Station Pump Replacement located at 5193 Rocky Mountain Drive; and

WHEREAS, performing the pump replacement to the Meadows 5 lift station wet well minimizes inconvenience to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Approval</u>. The application for a variance from the Town's Utilities Department beginning on October 11, 2016 is hereby approved subject to the following restrictions:

- 1. The variance shall be in effect between the dates of October 11 and 12, 2016.
- 2. The variance shall apply only to the pump replacement at the Meadows 5 lift station wet well located at 5193 Rocky Mountain Dr., and will include collection and hauling of wastewater flows. Any other work shall comply with the noise restrictions set forth in Chapter 9.16 of the Castle Rock Municipal Code.
