**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CASTLE ROCK
PUBLIC ART COMMISSION PUBLIC ART PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Castle Rock Public Art Commission has pursued a five-year guide for Town public art initiatives in the community;

WHEREAS, ninety-one percent of respondents to a 2017 questionnaire regarding public art believe public art adds value to Castle Rock – improving the look and feel of public places, commemorating history and heritage and inspiring conversation;

WHEREAS, the Town, through its consultant Art Management & Planning Associates Inc., has prepared an updated Public Art Plan that addresses the public art goals of the Town, and which has been approved by the Public Art Commission and presented to the Downtown Alliance; and

WHEREAS, the Castle Rock Public Art Commission Public Art Plan establishes a mission, vision and goals for Town public art initiatives over the next five years.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF
THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK AS FOLLOWS:**
