Description of Organization:	Clothes To Kids of Denver (CTKD) provides new and quality used clothing to students from low-income or in-crisis families in the Denver Metro Area, free of charge. Central to the CTKD mission is our Boutique, a 3,000 square foot space where preschool-12th grade students are invited to browse our wide selection of clothing for a 21-22 piece school wardrobe, which includes 5 tops, 4 bottoms (shorts, pants, dresses or skirts), 1 additional dress/skirt (optional), 1 pair of shoes, 1 coat, 5 pairs each of new socks and underwear and extras (accessories, school supplies, etc.). Students who qualify are invited to schedule an appointment to select a wardrobe of clothes twice in any 12-month period. CTKD's inventory comes from individuals, community clothing drives, retail stores and clothing manufacturers. CTKD purchases or encourages donations of new socks and underwear, as well as clothing and shoe sizes that are in short supply. CTKD's attractive store-like setting combined with our emphasis on providing shoppers with the best quality, selection and customer experience possible make CTKD the preeminent clothing resource for students in need in the 10 county Metro Denver. In 2016, CTKD distributed 7,977 wardrobes and 24,009 pounds of extra items, with more than 90% of shoppers selecting a complete wardrobe (all 21

	non-optional pieces). CTKD is on track to provide at least 9,500 wardrobes in 2016 and has provide nearly 43,000 wardrobes since opening in 2008.

Description of specific project for which funds are requested:	Grants funds will be used to help "Underwrite Our Underwear!". Individuals/groups donate most of the inventory in our boutique, but socks and underwear remain notoriously difficult to obtain through typical donations since they must be new. CTKD has negotiated discounts on these important basics and solicited donors for contributions through our Undie 500 and Socks in the City campaigns, yet still spends thousands of dollars each year to meet the need for these items. A grant of \$500 would provide 5 pairs of new underwear and 5 pairs of new socks for 70 students. This gift would make a huge impact considering CTKD currently serves an average of 50 shoppers each day and will provide roughly 1,500 wardrobes before the end of this year.

How does this project benefit Castle Rock residents?:	CTKD serves students residing in the 10-county Denver Metro Area, including the Town of Castle Rock and all of Douglas County. To be eligible for clothing from CTKD, students must either be receiving Free or Reduced Lunch through their school or referred by an authorized person or institution, such as a school employee, religious leader or human service agency. CTKD works with nearly 250 referral partners to reach children and youth in need. Schools and school districts in the Denver Metro Area refer just over half (51%) of the students that CTKD serves. The other half of shoppers are referred by human service agencies (41%), shelters and hospitals (6%) and faith based communities (2%). Since January of 2016, CTKD has had 257 students come from the Town of Castle Rock to select

a 21-piece school wardrobe. The number of students served from Castle Rock has grown each year since we opened services to you region in early 2015. We would be thrilled to receive continued funding from you, but even if we are not chosen, I would love to connect with someone in your office about getting the word out about our services in your area!
