ORDINANCE NO. 2018-004

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN'S ZONE DISTRICT MAP BY REZONING ROCK PARK TO PL-3 DISTRICT

- **WHEREAS**, the Town is the owner of Rock Park, more particularly described on the attached *Exhibit 1* (the "Property"), which is currently zoned Single-Family Residence District.
- **WHEREAS**, the Property's Single-Family Residence District zoning is inconsistent with use of a public facility, and
- **WHEREAS**, Town administration has initiated the rezoning of the Property to PL-3 District, and
- **WHEREAS**, temporary community events sponsored by the Town of Castle Rock, as permitted in the PL-3 Zone District, must be compatible with the Rock Park Management Plan, and
- **WHEREAS**, public hearings on the rezoning have been held before the Planning Commission and Town Council in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Castle Rock Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE ROCK, COLORADO:

- **Section 1. Zoning Approval.** The Property described in *Exhibit 1* is rezoned to PL-3 District and the Town's Zoning District Map is amended accordingly.
- **Section 2**. <u>Severability.</u> If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgement shall not affect the remaining provisions of this ordinance.
- **Section 3.** <u>Safety Clause.</u> The Town Council finds and declares that this ordinance is promulgated and adopted for the public health, safety and welfare and this ordinance bears a rational relation to the legislative object sought to be obtained.
