Goal: Educate the public about upcoming improvements to Founders Parkway and Allen Way to solicit feedback on design.

Key Messages:

- 1) As Castle Rock thrives, it's important infrastructure keeps up with demand. The purpose of this project is to ease congestion at the intersection of Founders Parkway and Allen Way and to improve access to northbound I-25 from Founders Parkway.
- 2) The intersection of Founders Parkway and Allen Way is one of the busiest in Town. The Town has heard driver concerns and is taking the lead on improvements to this intersection and the northbound I-25 on-ramp.
- 3) The improvements to this regional connection are a partnership among the Town, CDOT and Douglas County.
- 4) Improvements include:
 - a. Additional eastbound left turn lane from Founders Parkway to Allen Way
 - b. A dedicated right turn from Founders to Allen Way
 - c. An additional southbound right turn lane from Allen Way to westbound Founders Parkway
 - d. An additional I-25 northbound on-ramp lane
 - e. A second northbound through-lane at Allen Way and Allen Street
- 5) Design is slated for 2017, with construction expected in 2018. Part of design will be to determine project phasing to minimize disruptions to the traveling public
- 6) Total cost is about \$4.5 million. Almost half (\$2 million) will be covered by a federal grant; \$280,000 will come from the state; \$250,000 will come from Douglas County, and the Town will fund \$1.9 million.

7) CDOT did not have the funding at the time Founders Parkway was reconstructed in 2015, so the Town applied for a federal grant and received \$2 million in funding for construction, which becomes available to the Town in 2018.
