

ACC Castle Rock Collaboration Campus groundbreaking ceremony - May 21



CASTLE ROCK, Colo. (April 30, 2018) – A groundbreaking ceremony for the Arapahoe Community College Castle Rock Collaboration Campus will be held on Monday, May 21, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. on the 14-acre site in The Meadows.

The project is a joint venture among Arapahoe Community College, the Town of Castle Rock, the Castle Rock Economic Development Council, Colorado State

University and the Douglas County School District.

“ACC is very excited to expand our presence in Castle Rock to serve the community through this very unique educational partnership,” exclaimed Dr. Diana Doyle, President of ACC. “The ACC Castle Rock Collaboration Campus will be a dynamic model for progressive educational delivery at all levels.”

The campus will bring together education, business and the community to create a unique resource for delivering seamless education and workforce training to Castle Rock. CSU and DCSD will articulate with ACC to create a smooth pathway from high school diploma to associate degree to bachelor’s degree.

The two-phase project will consist of two buildings with an estimated opening of phase one in the fall of 2019. Joint engagement from ACC, CSU and DCSD with Castle Rock businesses and focus groups determined that the initial educational offerings will be in the areas of Business & Entrepreneurship, Health Care, Information Technology/Programming, General Education and Workforce Training.
