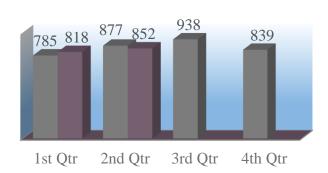

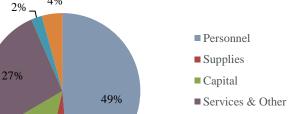

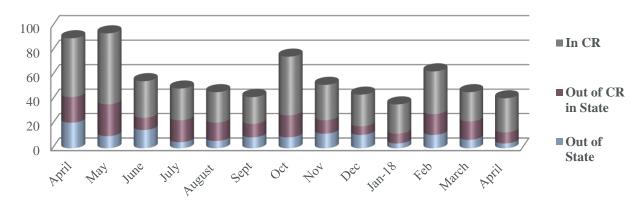

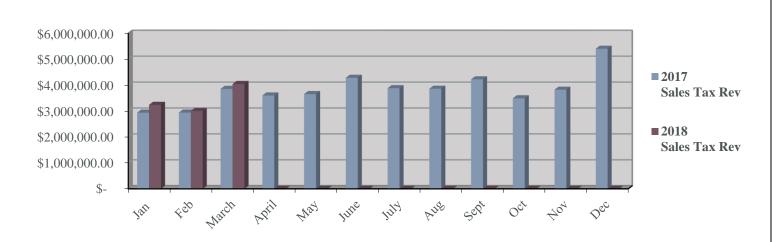
This graph illustrates how many business licenses are issued per month, by area.
