Whereas, Dan was a 20-year member of the Castle Rock Volunteer Fire department, serving as Chief in 1978 at the time of the Douglas County Courthouse fire; and

Whereas, Dan served on Town Council from 1978-1986; and

Whereas, Dan was an active supporter and sponsor of local youth in Castle Rock, coaching numerous youth sports teams, announcing the Douglas County High School football games, and was a bus driver for Douglas County schools from 1987 until 1995; and

Whereas, Dan enjoyed socializing with friends and could often be found smiling and laughing over coffee at the B&B restaurant, was an active member of our community, and had a strong commitment to helping Castle Rock grow and thrive.
