

PROCLAMATION OF COMMENDATION TO

Whereas, Brett Ford has represented District 7 on Town Council since 2014; and

Whereas, throughout his tenure on Council, Councilmember Ford represented Town Council on the Castle Rock Economic Partnership, the Water Resources Commission, the Centennial Airport Noise Roundtable, the Board of Building Appeals, and the Planning Commission; and

Whereas, Councilmember Ford's business mindset was often demonstrated in his work on Council, as he helped ensure Castle Rock had a comprehensive economic development strategy; and

Whereas, Councilmember Ford appropriately recognized traffic issues as a top community concern and worked to ensure the Town is doing everything possible within its resources to realize greater efficiencies in traffic operations; and

Whereas, keeping Castle Rock a world-class community as it continues to grow requires continued investments in infrastructure, which Councilmember Ford supported, resulting in the completion of Castle Rock Parkway/North Meadows Drive, the first delivery of WISE water to Castle Rock, the opening of Fire Station 152 and other key infrastructure projects in recent years; and
