## Summary of Potential Advancement of the Crystal Valley Interchange Project (CVI)

The Town currently has a Town Council approved Five-Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP). This CIP is prioritized to match projects identified within the Town's Transportation Master Plan that are recommended to be implemented in the short term against forecasted revenue constraints. This current CIP has some funding being set aside each year (\$500,000) for the CVI, but currently does not have specific project efforts identified. The current CIP list is summarized in the first table of the attachment.

If the CVI is advanced as a priority of Town Council in order to provide a \$20 Million contribution toward the project, in both cash contributions and products combined, certain adjustments from the CIP would be necessary in order to maintain a balanced budget across each of the five years. This adjusted CIP list is summarized in the second table of the attachment.
