An Award for Outstanding Achievement in Popular Annual Financial Reporting is valid for a period of one year only. The Town has received a Popular Award for the last two consecutive years (fiscal years ended 2016-2017). We believe our current report continues to conform to the Popular Annual Financial Reporting requirements, and we are submitting it to GFOA to determine its eligibility for another Award.


Total businesses licensed

This graph illustrates how many business licenses are issued per month, by area.




#### **Initiatives**
