COMMODITY OR SERVICE Raw Water Pipeline Installation

Per Municipal Code 3.02.060:

Purchases over \$1,000 and up to \$5,000 require three (3) verbal bids unless approved by the Town Manager on the basis of sole source, emergency or unresponsive bidder.

Purchases over \$5,000 and up to \$75,000 require three (3) informal written bids unless approved by the Town Manager on the basis of sole source, emergency or unresponsive bidders.

Purchases over \$75,000 require formal written sealed bids unless waived by the Town Council on the basis of sole source, emergency or unresponsive bidders.

The requesting department must provide written justification in addition to the one bid/quote to the Finance Department for review and forward it to the Accounting Manager. **Attach additional sheets as necessary.**

This is the only local contractor that has the ability and experience to install a horizontal directionally drilled pipe within a steel casing. The carrier pipe is required to be installed within a steel casing per the Union Pacific Railroad pipeline installation regulations.

Based on the Water Resources Supply Demand Model, the high population growth trend, the last two summer water demand seasons, and aging well infrastructure, additional water supply is needed to keep pace with increased water demands and firm supplies. The new well infrastructure will help firm and increase current supplies. Castle Rock Water recently contracted with Hydro Resources for the new Lanterns Wells drilling project. Time is of the essence on this project; not only do the three new wells need to be drilled, but well facility and raw water line construction need to be completed before the 2019 demand season begins.

Global Underground is the only local construction contractor that has the experience to install the Horizontal Directionally Drilled (HDD) portion of the Lanterns Well Facility raw waterline. The pipeline is designed with a HDD pipe under the Union Pacific Railroad and East Plum Creek. The railroad requires that pipe installed under their track be
