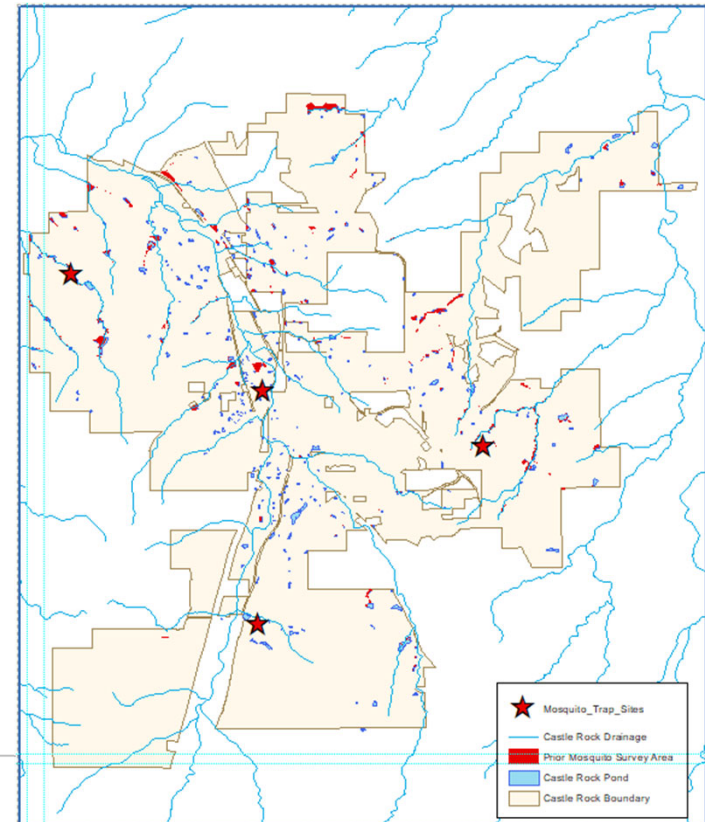
MOSQUITO ABATEMENT

BACKGROUND

- West Nile Virus Task Force Formed in 2003
- Castle Rock Water manages program through contract services
- Services provided:
 - Public and private open spaces inspected for open water and active mosquito breeding
 - Active breeding sites treated with larvicide
 - Adult mosquito surveillance in four locations throughout Town: Downtown, Founders, Meadows, and new site in Crystal Valley Ranch
 - Customer response and education

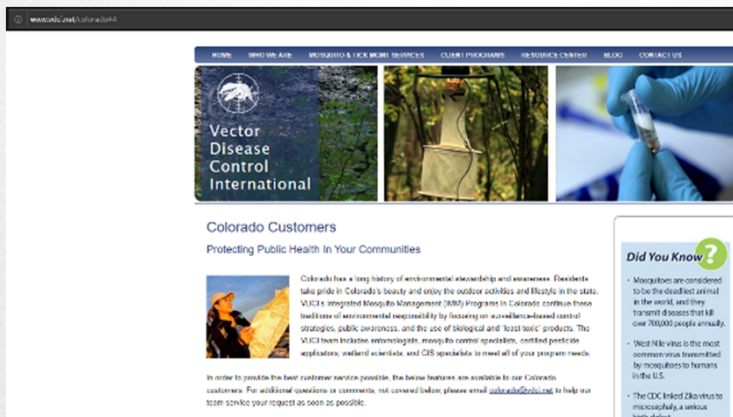
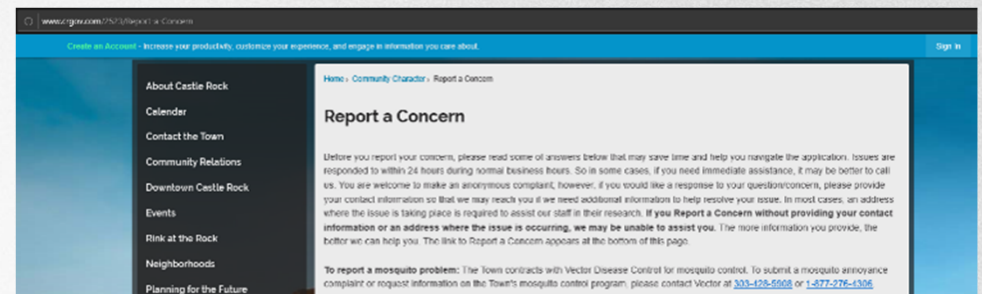
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INFORMATION

- The Town contracts with Vector Disease Control - International (VDCI).
- Contact VDCI at 1-877-276-4306 to report a mosquito problem.

MOSQUITO ABATEMENT

CONTINGENCY PLANNING

- Town coordinates with Tri-County Health on WNV health alerts
- Adult mosquito control available through VDCI
 - No spraying to-date
- Considerations for spraying include:
 - Reported cases of WNV in humans in Douglas County
 - Significant spike in WNV carrying mosquito counts in Castle Rock
 - A public health alert from TCHD
- Town to undergo public outreach prior to spraying
- VDCI accepts “No Spray” requests by address on their website

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Spray Notification and Shut-Off Requests

Please Utilize Form Below



The below form will alert the VDCI team that you desire a call notification prior to adult mosquito control spraying in your area. The form also provides the option to request that our team shut-off our spray machine while passing your residence. Please note that a shut-off does not guarantee that drift of insecticide material will not occur and it may decrease the effectiveness of adulticiding on mosquitoes in your immediate area. Please be aware that the call shut-off list is a service that VDCI provides to residents and may not be possible in the case of a West Nile Virus Public Health emergency, as experienced in 2003 and 2007.
