Town and state wide

Town Council approved the **2019 Budget**, **1**st **Amendment** on April 16.

The Budget Team is gathering information for the **2**nd **Amendment** that will go before Town Council this summer.

- 2020 Budget Development
 continues. Departments submitted
 numerous requests and will present
 them to the Town Manager and
 Budget Team first week of May;
 adoption planned for September
- 2019 Budget, 1st Amendment added \$88 million of expenditures, offset in part by \$6.6 million of revenue to the 2019 Budget. Total budgeted expenditures for 2019 are now roughly \$325 million Townwide.
- TABOR surplus not expected for 2018, based on unaudited information; updates/finalization will occur with post-audit calculations

On the horizon

May 7: Staff will present the 2019 First Quarter Financial Review to Town Council.

June 1: Highway Users Tax Fund (HUTF) report due; required for municipalities to receive this revenue that goes into the Transportation Fund

June 4: The Audit Committee will meet to review financials, and auditors will present results of the annual financial statement audit. The committee consists of the Town Manager, Finance staff, Council members and stakeholders.

Improving transparency continues

On April 11, the Budget Team participated in a webinar hosted by the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) on Case Studies in Online Financial Transparency. The session covered case studies, effective tools, best practices and how to engage more citizens.




