
## TRAINING CAMPUS AERIAL




### TRAINING CAMPUS HISTORY

- Campus development began in 2001 with live burn tower, 303 Malibu St.
- In 2006, the Town purchased land at 301 Malibu St., but has not developed that site up to now
- From 2014-December 2018, the Town leased classroom, office, and bay space at 1335 Park St.; lease terminated at owner's request
- In 2017, the Town purchased 1259 Park St., which has been remodeled and meets vehicle bay and office space needs
- Now, staff is seeking approval of a contract to construct a 6,000-square-foot classroom building at 301 Malibu St.

### NORTH BUILDING DETAILS

- Fire and Police departments collaborated on design with DLH Architecture;
  consists of multi-room training building with classrooms, tactical training spaces,
  and ancillary amenities, including parking
- 14 firms sought to submit bids; six were qualified to submit, and three bid:

Bryan Construction: \$1,682,673

Calahan Construction: \$1,701,500

• Buildings By Design: \$2,024,040

 Staff interviewed the two lowest-bidding firms and is recommending a contract with Bryan Construction, who was the low bidder

### PROJECT COST INFORMATION

Construction Cost: \$1,682,673

Town-Managed Contingency: \$160,000

Permits/testing/IT/FFE: \$521,028

Design Cost (allocated): \$114,190

Project Management (allocated): \$87,410

TOTAL: \$2,565,301

Funds Available: \$1,021,377 (from original 2017 appropriation)

Funds Needed: \$1,342,324

If Council approves the contract, funds will be included in the Second Quarter Budget Amendment

### **FUNDING SOURCES/SCHEDULE**

Staff is proposing using the same funding mix as initial 2017 appropriation:

Funds Needed:	\$1,342,324
General Fund (general tax dollars):	\$581,674
General Long-Term Planning Fund (building use tax):	\$223,721
Fire Capital Fund (impact fees):	\$214,772
Police Capital Fund (impact fees):	\$214,772
Facilities Capital Fund (impact fees):	\$107,386

If approved tonight, construction would begin immediately and is expected to be completed in early 2020
