HB 19-1087 - Posting of Public Meetings

Effective August 2, 2019, local governments are no longer required to physically post agendas for Town Council and Boards and Commissions meetings. Agendas must be posted on our website, be searchable, have links to all social media accounts, and provide for an emergency posting location.

The Town currently complies: An electronic board in the lobby scrolls upcoming meetings, agendas are posted on our website, and residents are notified through various social media accounts.

Solicitor Application Reviews

With the opening of the Townhall addition, the Finance department took over the administration, review and issuance of Solicitor licenses due to their proximity for a one-stop-shop for licensing.

Finance also issues Business licenses which goes hand-in-hand with verifying the validity of Solicitors.


