The Colorado Front Range Trail is a statewide-envisioned multi-use trail begun in 2003, which, when						
completed, will travel along the Front Range communities from New Mexico to Wyoming. This proposed						
project will construct nearly 5 miles in three missing segments of the Colorado Front Range Trail at its						
southern crossroads in Castle Rock, providing connectivity for this trail system from Denver through to						
southern Douglas County, opening a major recreational corridor for commuters, hikers, walkers,						
runners, cyclists and equestrians. The Town of Castle Rock is partnering with Douglas County Open						
Space and Natural Resources, Douglas Land Conservancy, Colorado Agriculture Leadership Foundation						
and two private residential development companies (Terrain-Starwood Ventures LLC and Toll Brothers						
Inc.) to complete these final segments. The southern segment of this project will extend the Town's

main paved north-south spine trail, the East Plum Creek Trail, 1.7 miles beyond the Town's southern boundary to connect to the Douglas County soft-surface trail system, which will eventually connect users south to Colorado Springs. The central and northern segments of this project will construct 3.3 miles of paved trail along McMurdo Gulch towards Cherry Creek, providing connectivity to the Cherry Creek Regional Trail and north to Denver. The Town of Castle Rock and Douglas County Open Space will coordinate trail development, with collaboration from the project partners.
