



- DMA to produce free, family friendly events in Downtown in 2020, at the same funding level:
 - Starlight Movie Series (up to four movies)
 - Car Show Street Party & Concert
 - 12th Annual Classic Rock Cruise In Car Show
 - Splash in the Park/Fun in the Sun (up to four events)
 - Street Party & Concert Series (up to four, including Boots & Brews)
 - Oktoberfest
