# **OTHER COMMUNITIES**

#### **ARVADA AND COMMERCE CITY**

• Arvada stopped working with sister cities three years ago because they did not see value in continuing. Commerce City's program has not been very robust in recent years.

#### **BRIGHTON AND LONGMONT**

- Brighton budgeted \$750 this year, plus \$610 in dues. The only staff support is for PR; the program is otherwise managed by residents. Brighton's sister city was selected based upon a local connection there. No broad impacts have been observed.
- Longmont says the greatest benefit is for students. The city budgets \$34,520 annually for its program, which has a staff liaison but is otherwise volunteer run. A local connection helped determine one of their sister communities.

# **OUR SCHOOLS AND OUTLETS**

#### LOCAL SCHOOLS

- DCHS doesn't support any particular program but encourages students to pursue opportunities. There are seven students from abroad studying at DCHS this year.
- ACC has upcoming short trips to Europe and the Caribbean and welcomes international students. The Sturm campus was modeled off of campuses in Germany and Switzerland.

#### **OUTLETS AT CASTLE ROCK**

• The Outlets welcomes international visitors, with the bulk coming from China, Germany, Brazil, Mexico, Canada and the UK. Denmark, Taiwan, Australia and Argentina round out the top 10 visiting countries.

### **BROAD TAKE-AWAYS**

#### **PROGRAM COST/ECONOMIC IMPACT**

- Sister Cities International says 42% of programs have a budget of \$5,000 or less, and 79% have a budget of \$25,000 or less.
- The economic impact on an individual community is difficult to measure, per the report.

#### **COMMUNITY SUPPORT**

 It's clear that initiating a program would require assistance from a number of interested community members. Without soliciting feedback, we're unsure what level of interest exists.
