New Sister Cities Program Looking for Participants

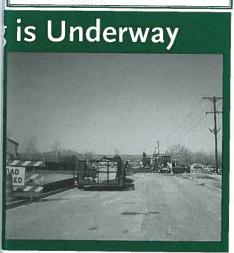
