**Title:** 2020 WISE Project Update Summary

### **Executive Summary**

The purpose of this memorandum is to summarize the 2020 Annual Water Infrastructure Supply Efficiency (WISE) Project Update presented to Town Council on March 3, 2020, specifically regarding impacts to the budget. In 2020, Staff anticipates spending the full 2020 budgeted amount of \$2,291,231 on 1,000 AF of WISE water deliveries, \$712,090 on securing the Douglas County Option water (bringing an additional 1,000 AF to the Town beginning in 2021), and \$7,459,000 on Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) including the Binney Connection, Well PA-3, Parker Water & Sanitation (PWSD) Bottleneck mitigation, and more. Further detail regarding water deliveries and CIP can be found in the full memo to Town Council dated March 3, 2020.

#### **Budget Impact**

As described in March 3, 2020 memo to Town Council, cost for the WISE project will be allocated from two accounts. The Other Professional Services account <211-4340-443.30-70> will be used to pay for charges associated with WISE water deliveries, and the CIP/WISE Infrastructure account <211-4375-443.77-72> will be used to pay for costs associated with WISE Infrastructure. Below is a summary of anticipated spending from each account with regard to the budget. **Exhibit B** breaks out specific costs expected in 2020 and details applicable Project Codes.
