

#### **BACKGROUND**


- Located at Ray Waterman Water Treatment Plant
- Anticipated production: 1.0 1.2 million gallons per day
- Equipping two new wells (Arapahoe / Denver)
- Designed for Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR)
- Pilot ASR downhole power generation valve
- Partnering with Dominion Water and Sanitation District



## WELLS CR-232 & CR-233 EQUIPMENT

#### **DETAILS**

- Hydro Resources selected through sole source
  - Limited available drilling contractors
  - High local demand for drilling projects
  - Compressed schedule
  - Partnering on piloting the new ASR power generation valve
- Hydro Resources provided pricing: \$2,293,335
  - Previous projects competitively bid
  - Separate Pilot Testing Agreement
    - Ongoing mechanical and technical support
    - Reduced costs
