WHEREAS, This holiday, called Arbor Day, was first observed with the planting of more than one million trees, and

WHEREAS, Arbor Day is now observed throughout the nation and the world, and

WHEREAS, Trees can reduce the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind and water, cut heating and cooling cost, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce oxygen and provide habitat for wildlife, and

WHEREAS, Trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires and countless other wood products, and

WHEREAS, Trees in our Town increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas and beautify our community, and

WHEREAS, The Town of Castle Rock has been recognized as a Tree City USA by the National Arbor Day Foundation and desires to continue its tree-planting ways, and

NOW, *THEREFORE*, I, Jason Gray, Mayor of the Town of Castle Rock, do hereby proclaim:
