


Attachment C - Investment Summary

Conservative financial management is a core priority of the Town. Successful management of the Town's cash balances and investments is important in order to support long range planning, as shown in the 2019 Budget and the 2019 – 2023 Five Year Capital Improvement Plan. The following includes information about the Town's cash and investment balances by Town fund. Please note that this information may vary from the fund balance information in *Attachment A* due to timing differences between budget and cash investment reporting. These balances include internal and external reservations of funds, and the accumulation of funding for future project needs. Additionally, the value of units in an investment portfolio can fluctuate and past performance is not necessarily indicative of future results. Net investment earnings based through December 31st are about \$2.9 million, including about \$77 thousand in corresponding professional service costs.

The Town maintains a conservative investment policy. The principal objectives include:

- Preservation and protection of capital
- Maintenance of sufficient liquidity
- Diversification to avoid unreasonable risk
- Attainment of adequate market rate of return
- Conformance with all stated regulations
- Investments held to maturity
